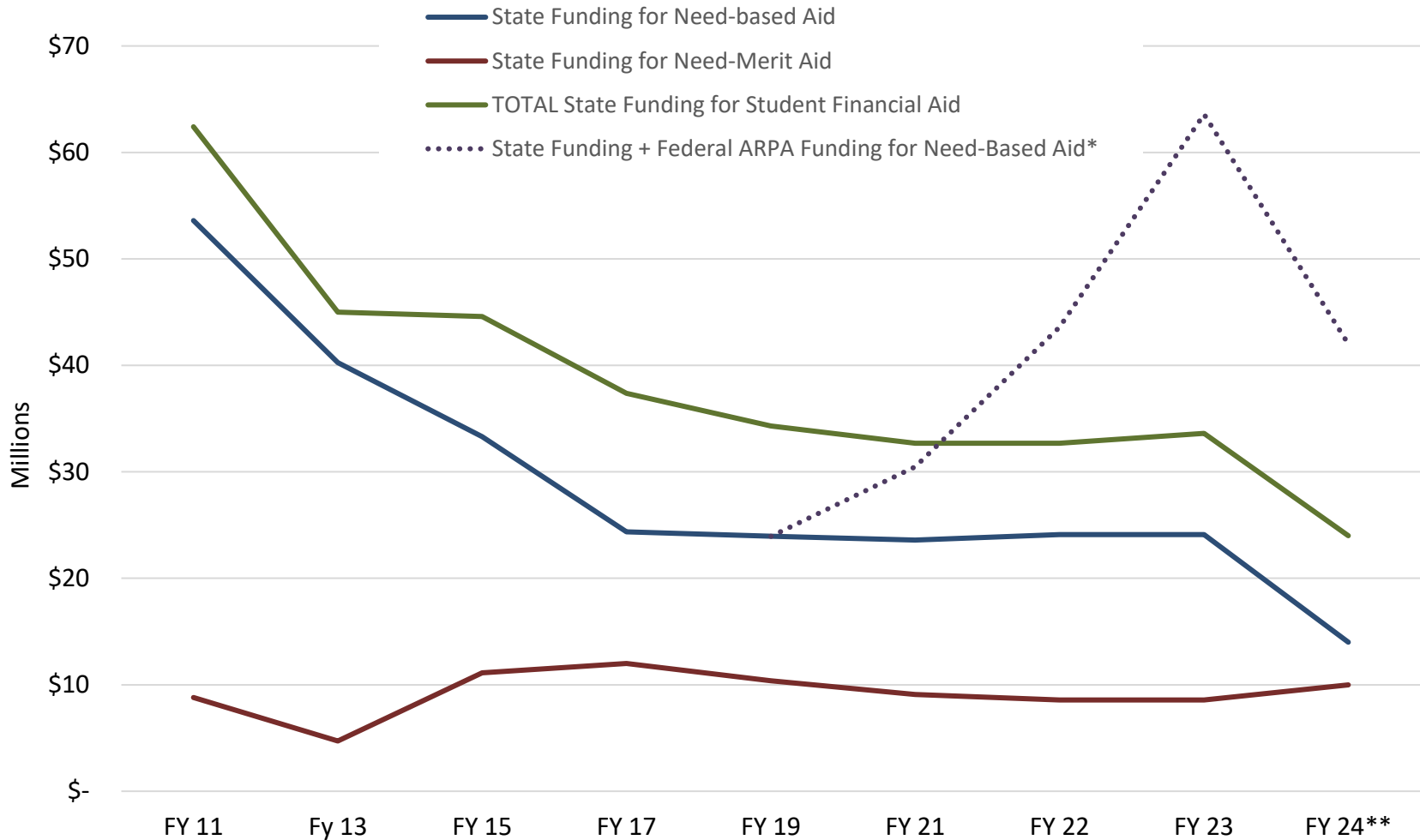

## Trends in Funding for State Financial Aid: FY 11 - FY 24

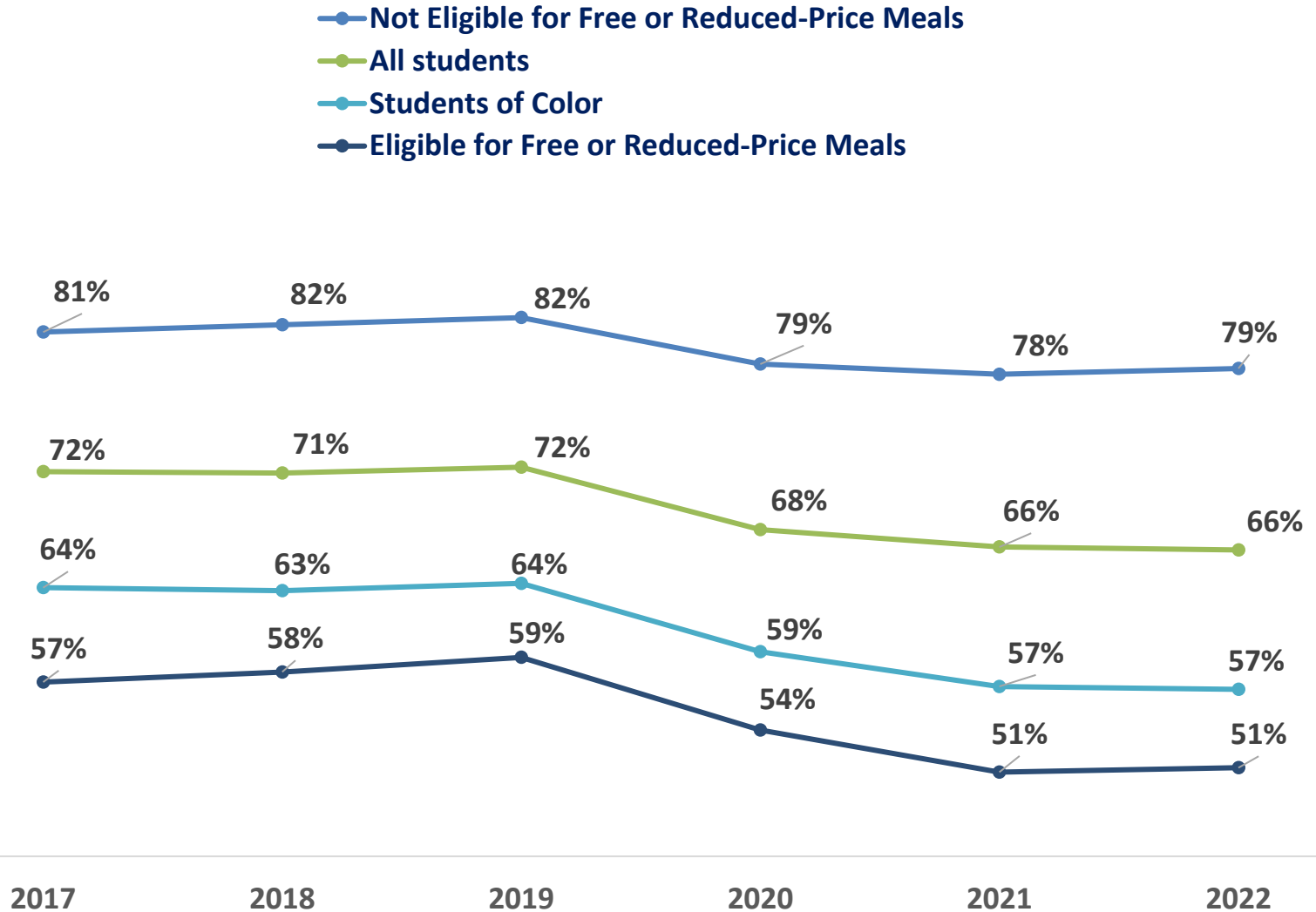


\*Nearly \$85 million in federal stimulus dollars has been allocated to the Roberta Willis Scholarship Program between FY 21 and FY 23.

# Percent of CT High School Students Enrolling in Post-Secondary, by Demographic Group and Graduating Class: 2017-2022

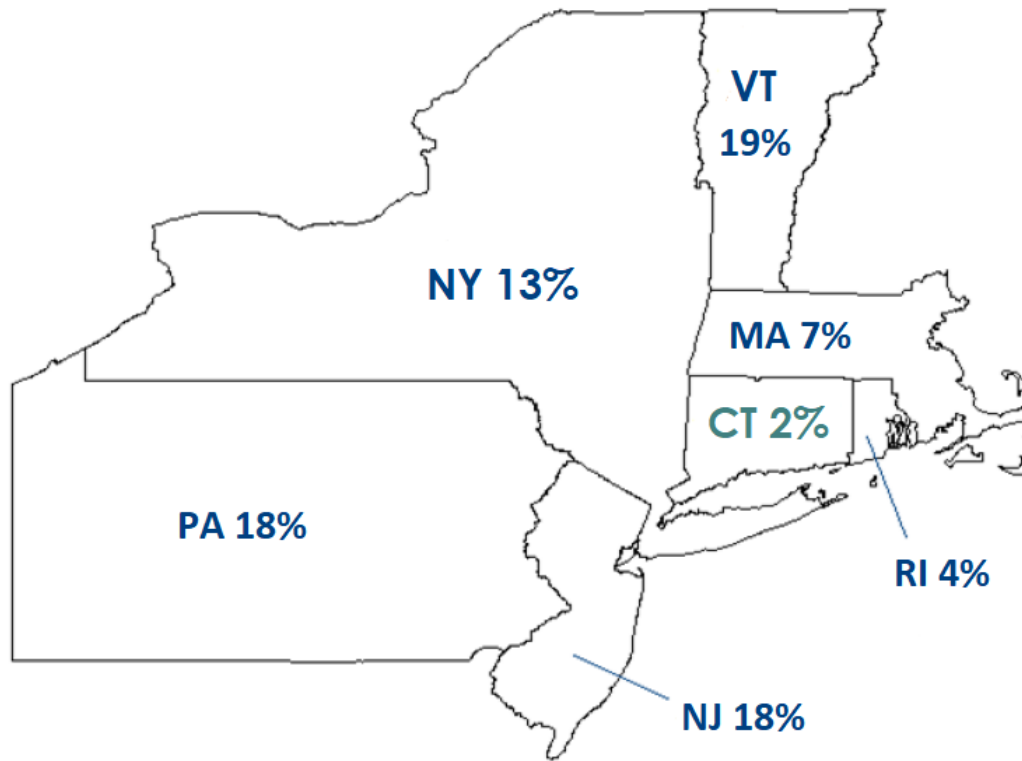

# High Percentage of Unmet Need in CT

Only 31% of eligible CT students received a state need-based grant in FY 22.

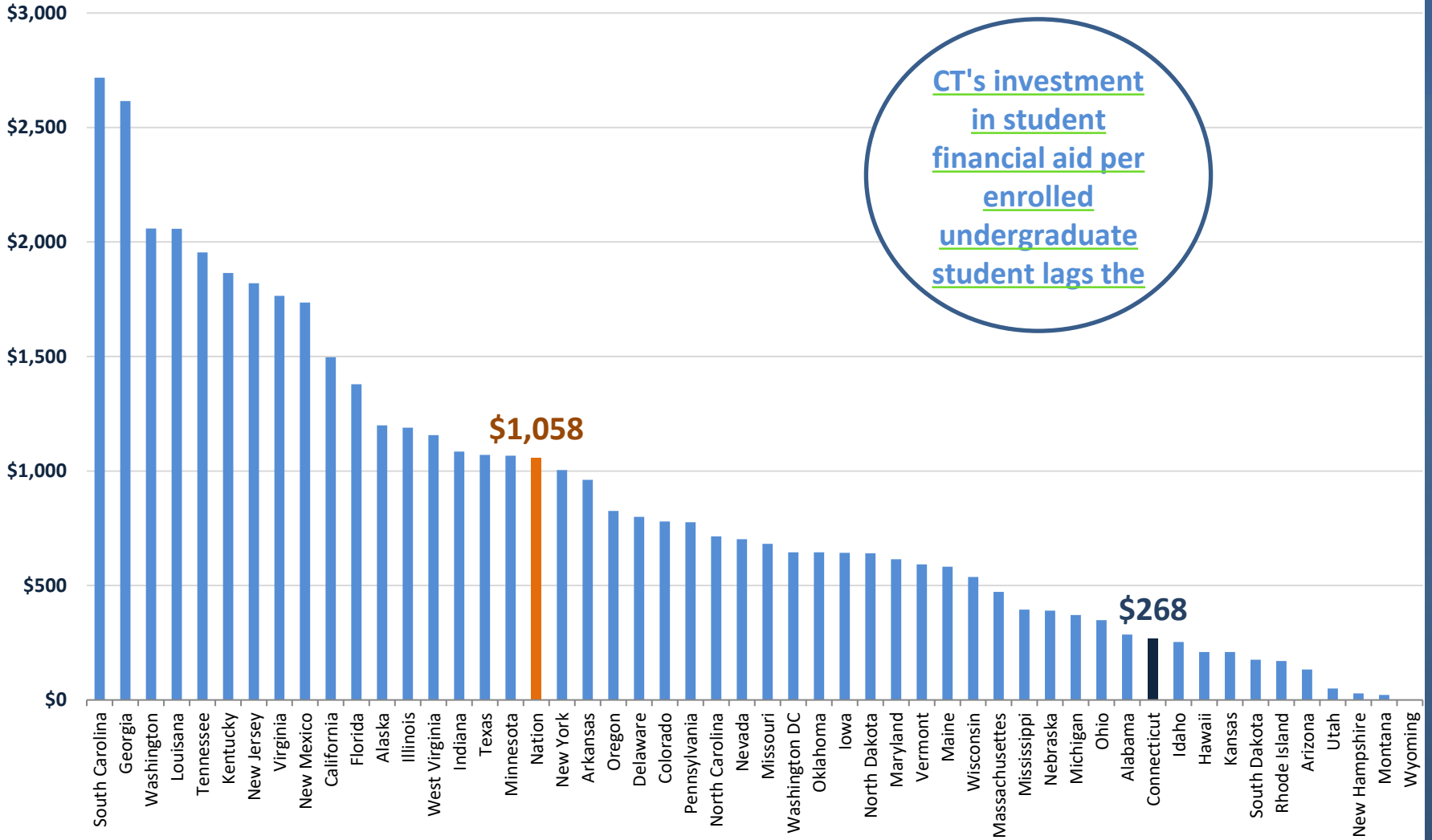

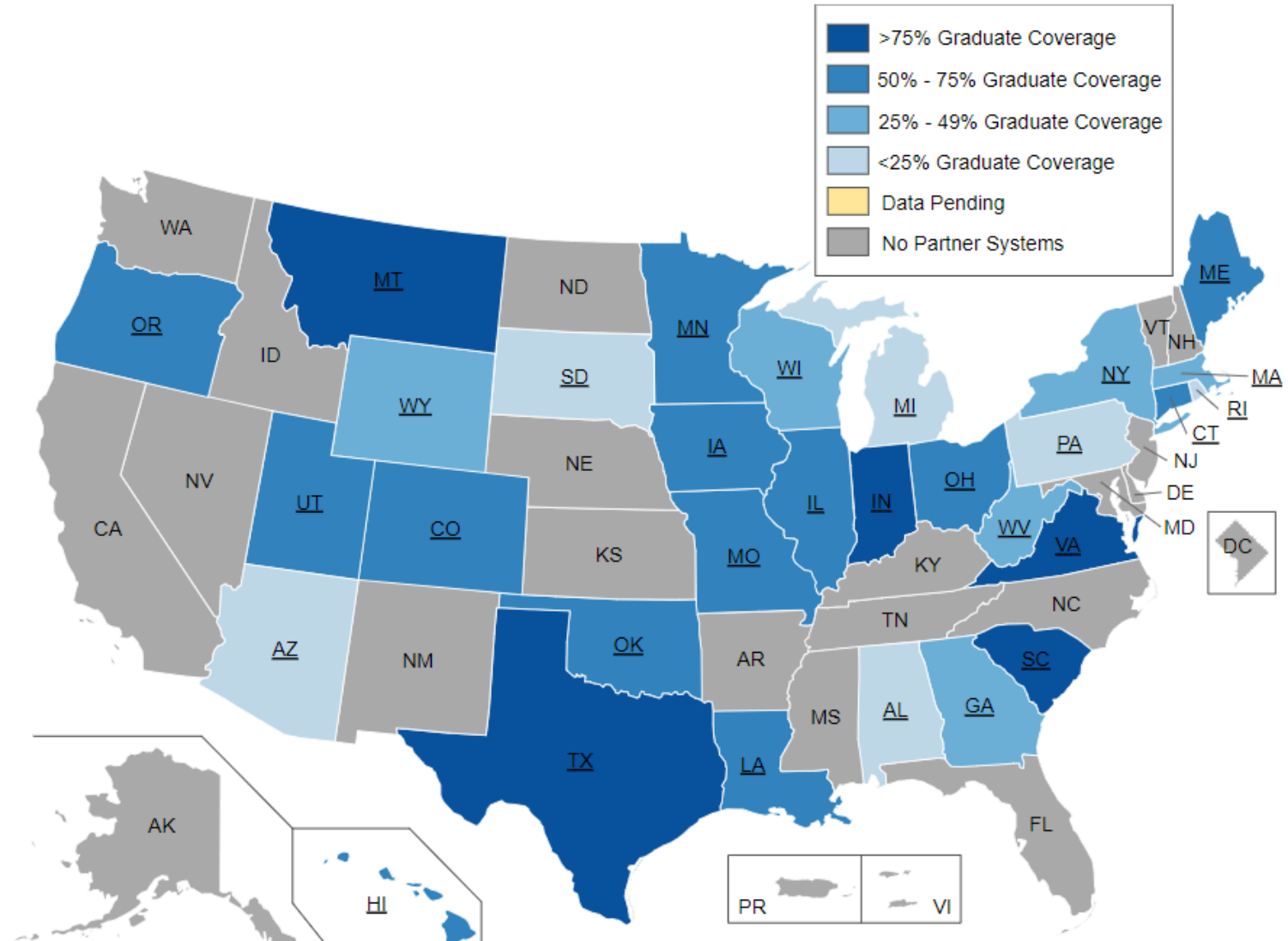

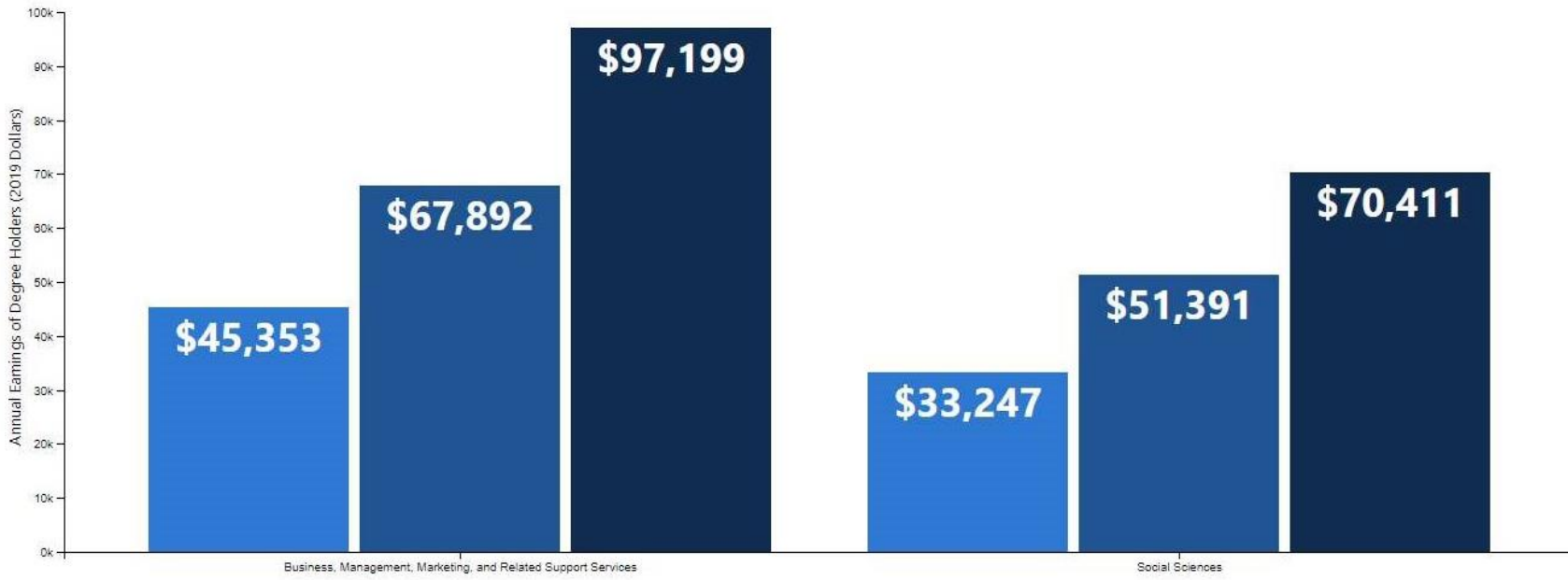

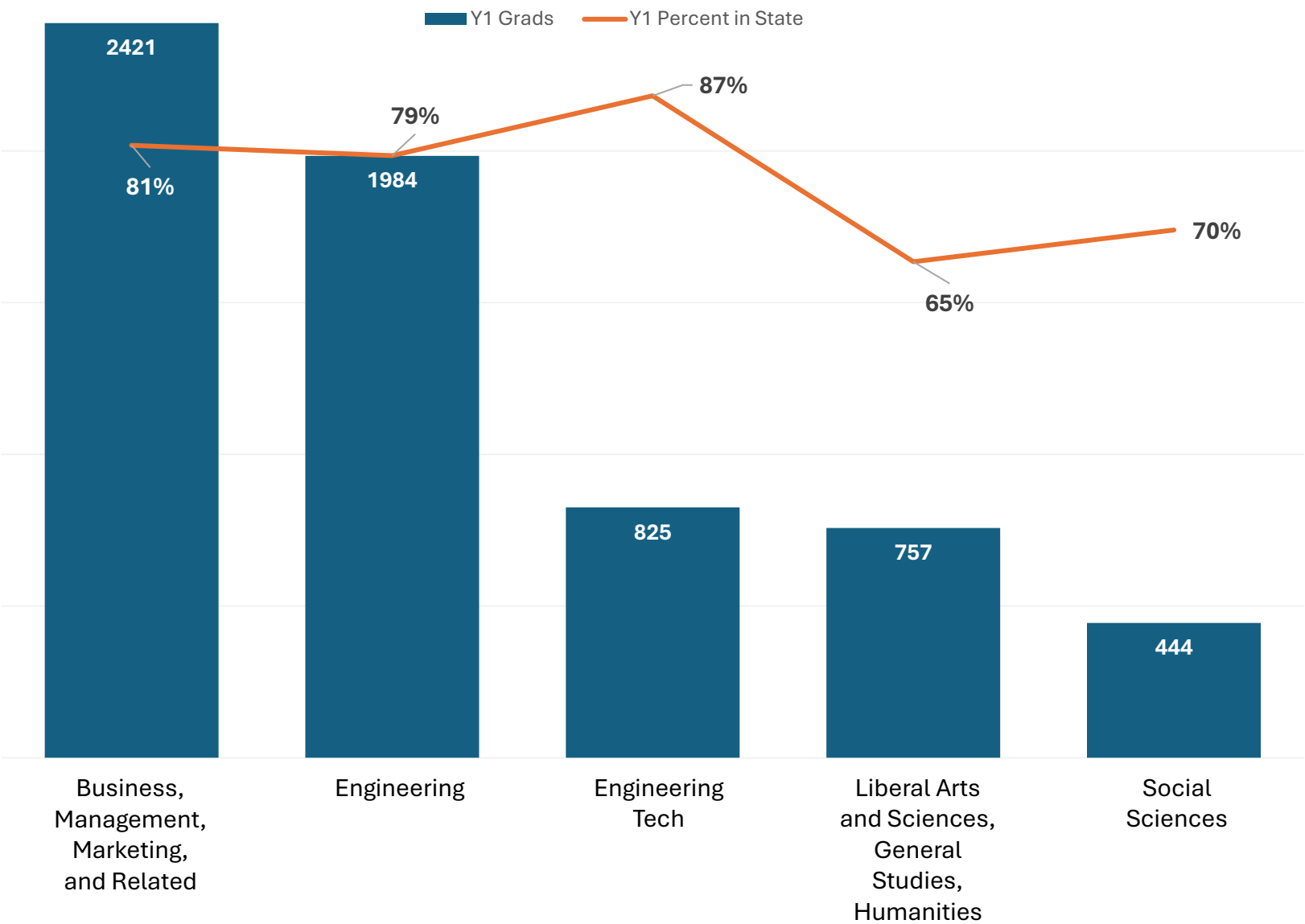

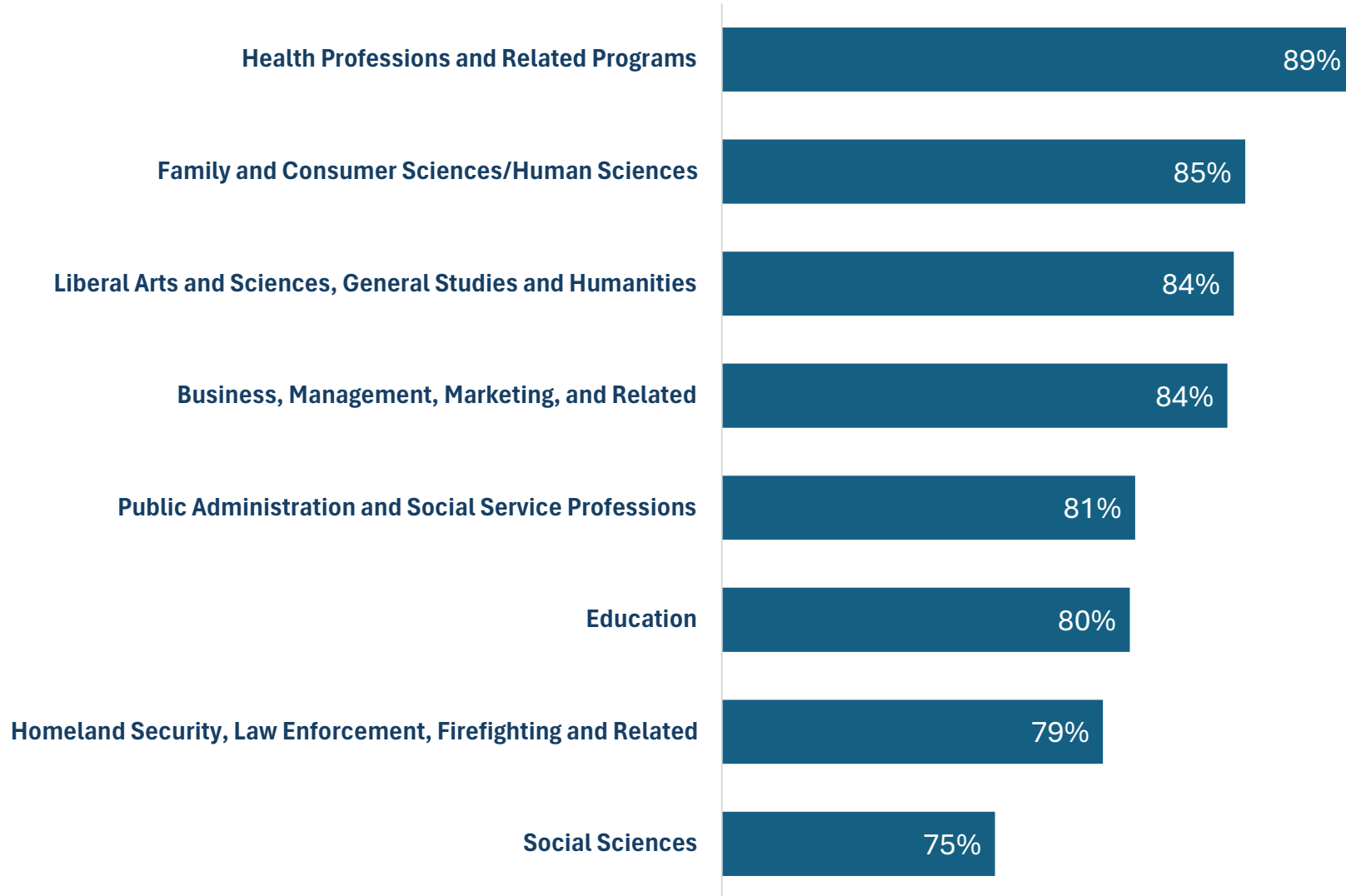
